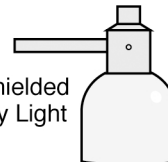

Full Cutoff Streetlight

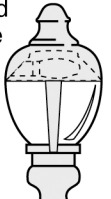

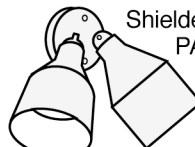
