- An eligible multi-family housing complex includes five or more units and receives electric service from Tucson Electric Power (TEP).
- A TEP program representative will review applications for completeness and program eligibility.

Application Process

- A TEP program technician will visit your facility and determine which products will be installed in all units.
- Program participants must complete this application agreement before products will be ordered and delivered.
- Participants must install all energy efficient products within 30 days of their delivery to the complex.
- A TEP program technician will perform an inspection to ensure all products have been installed and collect any uninstalled products.
